Your sins are forgiven

12 I write to you, little children, Because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake. (1 John 2:12)

We have redemption

7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace (Ephesians 1:7)

Blessed with every spiritual blessing

3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ, (Ephesians 1:3)

Qualified us for the inheritance

12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. (Colossians 1:12)

Provisions beyond human knowledge

9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him." (1 Corinthians 2:9)

Never left alone

5 Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5)

Will never remember your sin

12 And I will forgive their wickedness, and I will never again remember their sins." (Hebrews 8:12) NLT

No evil shall ever befall you

10 No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; n(Psalms 91:10)

Guaranteed long life

16 With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation." (Psalms 91:16)

Gives us our heart desires

4 Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. (Psalms 37:4)

He prepares us to please Him

13 For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him. (Philippians 2:13) NLT

He hides us in Himself

3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. (Colossians 3:3)

He blots out our transgressions for His own sake

25 "I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins. (Isaiah 43:25)

No hurt against us will prosper

17 No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue *which* rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness *is* from Me," Says the Lord. (Isaiah 54:17)

Guaranteed increase for you and your children

Not willing that one person should perish

Eternal Life is a promise from God

2 in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began, (Titus 1:2)

The promise is for now, and for that which is to come

8 For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come. (1 Timothy 4:8)

He makes it easy for everyone

21 And it shall come to pass *That* whoever calls on the name of the Lord Shall be saved.' (Acts2:21)

His gentle care for all
