

There is so much for us to learn about faith simply by observing the life of Jesus. In this article, I want to take a look at the practical side of faith, because this is exactly how Jesus lived. We are taught by the Word of God that the just shall live by his faith: "Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith" (Habakkuk 2:4). Faith that is not practiced is not faith at all. "Are you willing to be shown [proof], you foolish (unproductive, spiritually deficient) fellow,

that faith apart from [good] works is inactive and ineffective and worthless?" (James 2:20 AMPC).

In our general text, Jesus demonstrates His God-given authority and activates His faith in the middle of the storm. This is the faith attitude that I am looking to point out to you. There are always enough storms around to keep us strong in faith. The key to our developing this kind of faith is our continuous

hearing of the Word until we believe enough to do what it says. God gives us instructions in the book of Proverbs, "My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh" (Proverbs 4:20-22).

This present pandemic we are encountering is the perfect storm for us to demonstrate the faith and authority that God has given to the church. I beg of you to rebuke the fears and frustrations holding so many captive. Jesus is our example: He rose up with a faith attitude and rebuked the storm. We, the Church have the same authority today to rise up and rebuke storms that try to take us captive. Consider what Jesus said to

us in Luke's gospel, "Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you" (Luke 10:19). It is the power of the Holy Spirit that gives us this boldness to rise above our fears and take our rightful place in fulfilling the calling that God has given us. Oh, my dear brothers and sisters, let us rise up and take our rightful place and be the light God has called us to be. Remember what Jesus said to His disciples, "Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?"

Suppress fear with the Word of faith.



There is an old expression, my word is my bond. It means that your word is a bond, and a bond is an agreement with legal force. People use this expression to show that they stand behind the words they say. If I say it, I mean it...it is a promise. God's word is His bond. He said it, He meant it, and He is asking you to take Him at His word.

Many times throughout the scriptures, God has asked as He did in Numbers 14:11 when He asked Moses, "How long will these people reject Me? And how long will they not believe Me, with all the signs which I have performed among them?" Even today, with a Bible filled with miracles, He is asking, "How long...?" His word is truth. "For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us" (2 Corinthians 1:20).

"Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie

down, and when you rise up. And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth" (Deuteronomy 11:18-21). His word is clear and He has given it to us so that our days will be multiplied on earth. His word should be in us and before us; we are to bind or fasten it tightly as a sign of a promise made a long time ago. If we do this, we should never walk in fear.

But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; you are Mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you. For I am the Lord your God, The Holy One of Israel, your Savior; I gave Egypt for your ransom,

Ethiopia and Seba in your place. Since you were precious in My sight, you have been honored, and I have loved you; therefore I will give men for you, and people for your life. Fear not, for I am with you" (Isaiah 43:1-5a). Then He says, "Put Me in remembrance; let us contend together. State your case, that you may be acquitted" (Isaiah 43:26). Yes, He said we can remind Him of His promises to us. When the enemy comes to steal the Word from us, we can say, Lord, You said that You would never leave me or forsake me. You said that You healed me and delivered me from the hand of the enemy. Reminding Him of His word, reminds us of His promises to us and that they are binding.

I am reminded of the story of the Shunammite woman found in 2 Kings 4:8-37. She was a wealthy woman who asked her husband to make a small room for the Prophet Elisha. She knew he was a "holy man of God, who passes by us regularly" (2 Kings 4:9). For this, Elisha wanted to bless her, but she asked for nothing. Gehazi, his servant told Elisha that she did not have a son and that her husband was old. Elisha told her that about that same time in the following year, she would have a son and she did. After some years had passed, the boy

died. She took her child and laid him on the bed in the room she had made for Elisha. She then set out to find him. She did not tell her husband or Gehazi, but went straight to the man of God and said, "Did I ask a son of my lord? Did I not say, 'Do not deceive me'?" Then he said to Gehazi, "Get yourself ready, and take my staff in your hand, and be on your way. If you meet anyone, do not greet him; and if anyone greets you, do not answer him; but lay my staff on the face of the child." And the mother of the child said, "As the Lord lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you." So he arose and followed her. (2 Kings 4:28-30) She contended with the man of God, and told him she would not leave him until he did what he said. She knew his word was his bond, and she was not going to release him from his promise. He honored his word and her son was raised from the dead.

This is a picture of God and His children. "...And they drew near to the gates of death. Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions" (Psalms 107:18b-20). That is why He said to "lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your





hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates" (Deuteronomy 11:18-20).

As we are in the last days before Jesus's return, we should not be moved by the events around us. He foretold us what was to come, but more importantly, He sent His Word and left His word to act as an agent on His behalf. We are to keep it before our eyes, and in our hearts. We should speak it and repeat it and believe it and teach it. He even gives us an illustration of how His word works. "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the

sower and bread to the eater, so shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it" (Isaiah 55:10-11).

God loved us so much that He gave us Jesus. "Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. We love Him because He first loved us" (1 John 4:17-19).

As He is, so are we in this world. We are His children because of a covenant promise He made and His word is His bond, an agreement ratified by the blood of Jesus. We stand on His Word for His Word is truth.

A preacher once explained grace with this acronym:


God's - Riches - At - Christ's - Expense PRAY THIS PRAYER OUT LOUD:




Since when is Jehovah Rapha the Lord Who is our Healer not enough?


Since when is the perfect peace of the Lord Jesus Christ, who is our Prince of Peace not enough?


It is easy to fall into the trap of fear especially



Dear Harmony Church Family,

I was inspired by today's message to share a small excerpt with Pastor Alston. On the night of July 31, 2020, God not only gave me revelation on the purpose He has for my life, but He revealed the purpose of life in general and how His creation is expected to remain in a ceaseless communion just as Christ and God are in an unbreakable fellowship. God is so abundant in nature that He took even more time to explain to me how Satan has swayed earth's inhabitants. Since the beginning, Satan has been perverting the will of God in a way that prompts the world to move in a direction opposite of God's plan for us. If believers are to escape the lies of Satan, they must fully submerge themselves into Christ.

Humans are social beings and the "only" species on this planet that utilize a spoken language to communicate. Furthermore, we are all born with a natural inclination to not only depend on, but fellowship with one another. For example, a baby inside or outside his mother's womb is fully dependent on the union, fellowship, or bond of his mother. This chapter of life provides the first clue regarding the purpose of life. However, somewhere along the line mankind has developed its own

ideology of life. As a result, the true meaning has become perverted as people replace humility with selfishness, ultimately polluting the original definition. Now, instead of using God's gifts of sociability, people buy homes to move away from other people. People buy cars to drive away from other people. People buy plane tickets or planes to fly away from other people. People buy cell phones to degrade other people and take to "social" media with the sole intent of taking photos called "selfies". The perversion of sociological advancements has changed the course of life on earth. To redirect this current course, I can only ask that we continue in the pursuit of knowledge of Jesus Christ and continue in a manner that denounces the promotion of self but encourages the spirit of humility.


"...But truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord" (Numbers 14:21 NKJ).

"Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;" (Philippians 2:3-11).

Pastor has spent many years encouraging believers like myself, and I believe God commanded me to send my testimony to serve as encouragement for him. 




