





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
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How To Avoid Distractions





I believe that this would be the instructions from Jesus for us in this hour:



Have Faith in His Love

Jesus was sleeping at the back of the boat with his head on a cushion. The disciples woke him up shouting, "Teacher, don't you care that we're going to drown?" Mark 4: 38 NLT

The disciples are in the boat with Jesus in the middle of the lake. Suddenly, dark clouds roll in. The wind picks up and the water is choppy. The boat begins to rock. Darkness increases. Winds blow fiercely making waves crash over the side of the boat. The disciples begin bailing the water out. As fast as they throw it over the side, larger waves come and they are drenched. The boat is swamped with water. They can't keep up. Fear stirs in their hearts. How can He sleep through this storm? Why won't He wake up? Out of desperation, they wake Him asking, "Teacher, don't you care that we're going to drown?"

All of us experience storms in life. We may relate to the disciples' fear. The rent is due and I don't have the money. The doctor said I have cancer. My husband wants a divorce. Like the disciples, we don't doubt that God can help us. We know He can. What we question is does He care enough to do it? Some say "He's too

busy helping other people to help me"; others, "He's not going to help me. I don't deserve it." Believing that God will not care enough to help them, they never ask.

After calming the storm, Jesus asks the disciples, "Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?" (Mark 4:40). Faith is the antidote to fear and doubt. We may have faith in His Mighty Power, but do we have faith in His love? Romans 5:8 says, "God showed His love for us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." God sent His Son to suffer and die a horrible death on a cross for us because He, the Most High God, loves us and wants an intimate relationship with us. That's what I call love. First Peter 5:7 urges us to cast our care upon Him for He cares for us. So, to answer the question does God care for me, yes, He cares for you. He loves you. Now it's up to you to believe it, to have faith in His love.



God's Existence and the Cost of Sin

We are told in the Scriptures "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear" (1 Peter 3:15). This is a key verse in the Bible. It gives all Christians the directive to be prepared to explain their faith and why they have it. This is the basis of Christian Apologetics. We do not all need to be deeply trained and educated theologians to answer as to why we believe, but we should be ready to give our testimony and explain why it is we are certain of our faith. At the very least we should be able to point to the examples God leaves for us in the world around us as proof of His existence. There is really nothing in the Bible that proves the existence of God; His existence is presumed by all the writers. As such, this article may seem light on Scripture references, but this is not about finding proof of God's existence in the Scriptures. This article is about finding the evidence of God He has left in plain sight for all man to see.

One proof of God's existence is existence itself!

The fact that the whole universe in all its complexity exists is proof there is a Creator beyond our ability to understand, who made and directs the actions of all the stars, planets, and other heavenly bodies in the universe. We know God does not direct our steps, but the "non-sentient" things like the moons and stars do the same things over and over with such predictability we can know where they will be in each moment throughout time, past or future, is a remarkable thing... how could this "just happen"? It is completely silly to think all the things in the Universe, even just the life forms on Earth, could simply have just "worked out that way".

Let us look at some things we know about the field of mathematics. Pi, the number used to calculate the circumference of a circle, is the same every time. People have calculated the value of pi to amazing lengths and the number keeps going without repeating or running out, kind of like God, except Pi has a beginning "3.14" it just never ends. The remarkable thing about numbers is they are always the same and they always work.

Is this just a "freak of nature" that these things are always the same no matter what the conditions? I find randomness harder to believe than a benign creator building in stability and laws for how things should work.

Other examples would be that using a simple equation we can calculate the exact diameter of a circle, or the volume of a cylinder. Even more simply, one plus one always equals two. The sheer simplicity of the exactness of mathematics shows, in and of itself, the theory of a random evolution of the universe just simply does not hold water.

I know, we are not subject to the law! These are not those kinds of laws, these are not choices, but rather things which govern the way the universe works. It would be ludicrous to believe that on some other planet the number we call Pi could equal something else, it is the same everywhere in the Universe, anything else would exhibit Chaos and unpredictability, and we know it is not because we can observe it and quantify it.

Now let us look at the human body. The fact the body works in the way it is supposed to, if we do not abuse it, is remarkable. Our bodies have natu-

ral healing ability! We do not need a healing service because we got a paper cut, our bodies can heal many things without even needing a doctor, and just think about all the thing's doctors know how to treat! This amount of knowledge is amazing!

Some would have us to believe we descended from apes, and that before this, we were fishlike beings who crawled up onto the land. This is what many in the world would call a law, but it is not, the fact it cannot be proven makes it a theory, and this is all it ever will be, because proving evolution is impossible. Ok, here the non-believer would say proving God's existence is just as impossible, but any true believer has had personal contact with the Lord God and knows what His touch feels like. Anyone who feels His touch cannot help but to be a believer, it is that powerful!

We as believers know God exists because we have felt His hand in our lives over and over. We know when something good happens to us it is a blessing, and when something bad happens it is because of the presence of the curse in the world that we are subject the laws of sin and death. We as





believers know we were not meant to die and decay, but we were meant to live forever in communion with our Lord. We know Jesus' sacrifice to pay the debt for our sins was not what God had in mind when He created man. We also know He knew before creation all of this would happen and He would need to do something incredible to satisfy the laws He declared to be at the beginning. It would have been far simpler for God to not start this whole thing in the first place.

Let us look at the Passion of our Lord for proof. We know through sacred texts the things Jesus endured for our sakes. We also know these things through documented secular history. What none of these things go so far as to say is the totality of what Jesus suffered should not have been survivable. The scourging which tore the very meat off His blessed bones should have killed Him, yet He said nothing. Most people were only tied to crosses at that time, but our Lord was nailed to His. He suffered more than anyone else in history has or will

suffer, because during this He was "abandoned" by God. God turned His head and let all these things happen because He had to! God set certain things in place at the time of creation. Knowing He Himself would have to submit to unimaginable suffering and death, still He, God, must work according to the rules He established, they are not breakable, or He is not God.

God the almighty being, the Creator, the Lord of life, established the penalty for sinning against Him. Why? Because sins are violations of the rules of order God created. They are not only violations against what He said, but against nature itself. Sins are affronts to God not because He is a tyrant, but because He created everything to work in the way it should. Sinning violates the way creation is supposed to function. What is the cost? The cost is the presence of the enemy in the world. Adam and Eve messed up bad and invited the lord of darkness into the laws of the world. Prior to the fall, Satan could do nothing. He had been

cast down to earth, but had no ability to act on creation. He had been stripped of the powers of the angels and was made to simply observe the communion between God and His creation, and no longer had the ability to be with God in eternity. He was very simply stripped of his identity and hates man because of the potential man has which Satan can no longer have.

Rooted in the Word



"He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper" (Psalms 1:3 NKJ).

Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promises to His people and in Him we have life. Jesus said, "I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly" (John 10:10b). The definition of abundance is an ample quantity. Ample means enough or more than enough; plentiful, large and accommodating. Jesus said *more abundantly*. I challenge you with this...your level

of abundance is determined by how deep your roots are in the word of God.

The roots of a plant anchor it, giving it the ability to resist forces of nature. The roots also take in oxygen, water, and nutrients from the soil. The deeper the roots, the stronger the plant because deep roots in-



crease the intake of water and nutrients. Likewise, the rich soil is important because it holds the roots and stores nutrients. In the *Parable of* the Sower, Jesus talks about the importance of good soil. "Behold, a sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them. Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them. But others fell on good ground and vielded a crop: some a hundredfold, sixtv. thirty" (Matthew 13:3-8).

The seed that fell on good ground yielded a crop, but not all crops yielded a hundredfold. Now, the point is to yield a crop, but if the farmer was to examine the crops, I would imagine that the crops that produced the most were the crops with the deepest roots, which were able to receive the best of the water and nutrients available to them. I would also think some cultivation had to take place. Cultivation is the act of digging up an existing soil bed to better prepare it for planting. There is a breaking up to remove weeds and a loosening of the soil to help with the penetration of air, water, and nutrients. Jesus uses this metaphor for the heart of man, and we understand that the seed is the word of God. When we come to Christ, we crucify our flesh, we humble ourselves before Him, and we allow the word of God to take a dominant place in our hearts. "For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires" (Hebrews 4:12 NLT). This starts the


cultivation process of preparing our minds to be transformed and our hearts to be filled with the Holy Spirit, so that we become new creations in Christ Jesus.


"Therefore hear the parable of the sower: When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it. then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside. But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles. Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful. But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands it. who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold. some sixty, some thirty" (Mathew 13:18-23 NKJ).

"As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving" (Colossians 2:6-8 NKJ). "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper" (Psalm 1:1-3).

We are to be like that tree planted by the rivers of water, which never has to worry about a drought. For it to stand by the river, means its roots are so deep in the rich soil that it will not move when the water rises or wither when the water is low nor burn when the sun is hot. Like that tree, we should be rooted and built up in the word of God. We "study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15) so that we live the abundant life Jesus died to give us.







GOD LOVES YOU

JESUS DIED FOR YOUR SINS

YOU CAN RECEIVE JESUS NOW AND KNOW GOD'S LOVE

The basis of the Prayer of Salvation comes from Romans 10:9-10, "If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved."

However, I would like to direct you to Ephesians 2:8-9, "For by Grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God; Not of works, lest any man should boast."

Grace is mentioned over 100 times in the Bible. Grace is God's unmerited favor and because of God's grace, we receive eternal life and a promise of heaven. Grace is necessary for salvation as we cannot do enough good works or make enough right choices to earn our salvation. The Bible teaches that we are justified by the grace of God (Romans 3:24; Titus 3:7). Justified means declared not guilty. When we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, all charges against us are dropped and we are free from sin. When God forgives our sins, the record is wiped clean. It is as if we had never sinned.

A preacher once explained grace with this acronym:

God's - Riches - At - Christ's - Expense PRAY THIS PRAYER OUT LOUD:
