# Resting In God's GRACE

*For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them"*  
*[Ephesians 2:8-10]."*

Having an understanding of grace for me has been the one thing that has eliminated all anxieties. When we really listen to Father's instructions to us in reference to our newfound relationship with Him, there is no pressure at all. According to our study text above, everything that is required of us, Jesus has already done. God has rescued us through the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus. The only thing we need to do is receive what God has done. Notice that God calls salvation a gift. There is never any work required to receive a gift. The only work that accompanies a gift is to say

THANK YOU. The wonders of grace allow God to freely give us salvation. This wonderful grace is a revelation. The human mind cannot receive this grace. It must be revealed by the Holy Spirit. This is seen in Matthew 16:13-17:

"When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?"

So they said, "Some say John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets."



He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed *this* to you, but My Father who is in heaven."

We must be diligent in attending to the word of God until we receive revelation. If we are not careful in our thinking, we will find ourselves attempting to do religious works to receive salvation. The scriptures clearly tell us that it is not by works, but by grace we are saved. This is the great mystery of grace. In I Peter 1:10-13, he discusses the mystery on this grace:

"Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace *that would come* to you, searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into. Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ...."

Look with me if you will at John 6:28,29 in the NLT: “They replied, “We want to perform God’s works, too. What should we do?” Jesus told them, “This is the only work God wants from you: Believe in the one he has sent.”

The love that we have for our children is a picture of God’s grace. Your child does not need to do anything for you to love and care for him. We are now children of God by covenant promise, and that is His grace that goes beyond hu-

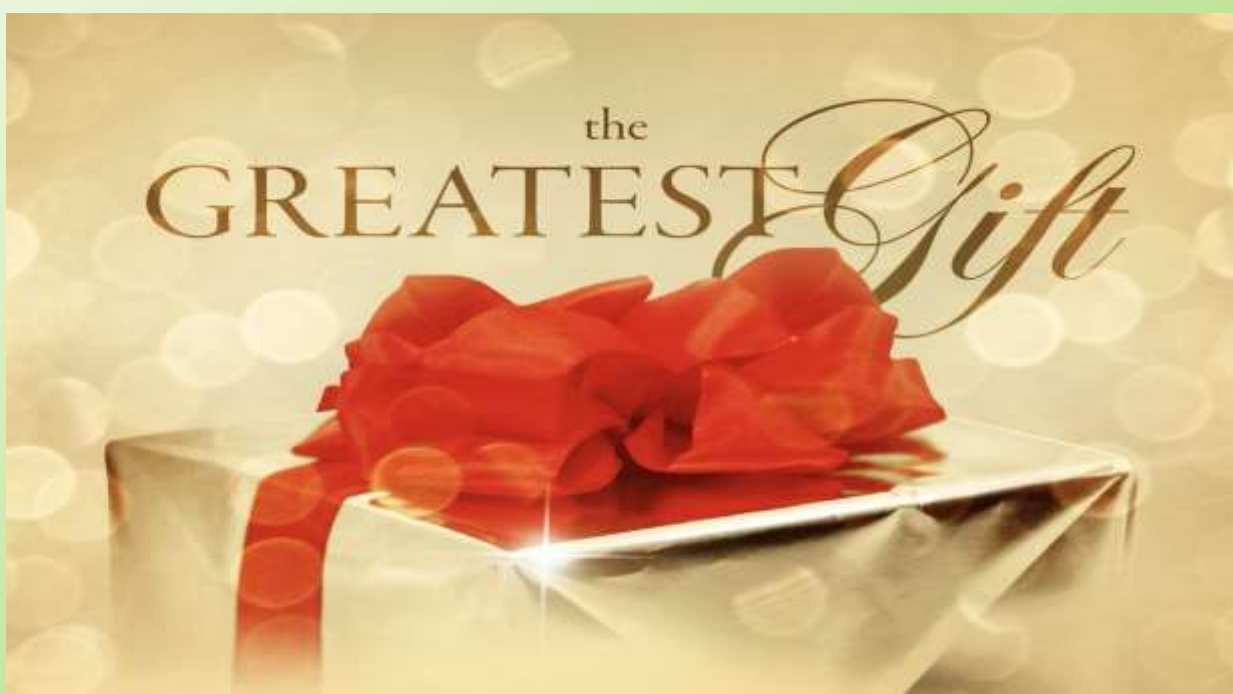
If creation is waiting with joyful anticipation for the sons of God to be revealed, imagine the jubilation of creation when Jesus was about to make His advent into the earth.

## ***Deacon Hugh F. Stewart, Jr. & Deaconess Voncella Stewart***

Deacon Hugh F. Stewart, Jr. has been with Harmony from the beginning. He was part of the group that began meeting in the basement of Pastor Owen Alston's home in 1990, when the church was incorporated. Along with Deacon Joseph Green, now deceased, he became a founding board member, a position he maintains. Hugh was the first deacon and his wife Voncella, the first deaconess. When the church Harmony Ministries began holding formal worship services in 1991, he and Voncella were there. For thirty-one years, Hugh and Voncella have been faithful members of Harmony Ministries U.S.A., Incorporated.

Although he was born in Martinsville, Virginia, Hugh grew up in Toms River and graduated from Central Regional High School. After high school, Hugh began working as an auto mechanic, a job which he continues to this day. As a young man, Hugh did not attend church. He was a disc jockey in clubs and house parties on the weekends, but he would watch Pastor Fred Price on the "Ever Increasing Faith" program on television every Sunday. He admits, "Though I only attended church on Christmas and Easter, the interest was always there." Life changed for Hugh after he married Voncella. She grew up in the church. Her grandfather was the founder of



the Community Baptist Church in Beckerville, New Jersey which she attended. While they were dating, Hugh would drop her off at the church and pick her up after, but did not come inside. After they were married on February 23, 1985, Hugh began attending church with his wife. Three weeks later, he walked up to the altar and gave his life to the Lord. He recalls, "I had an earlier experience with God. I saw what was going on in the world. I saw people I knew going to church and that night they would be in the bar drinking. I told Him that was not what I wanted. I want to be married when I get saved. I want something different."

As a "new creation in Christ, Hugh noticed immediate changes in himself. "Before I got saved, I cussed. After I got saved, He took that immediately. I did not have to get rid of it. Before I did not like to read and He gave me a love for reading." Voncella adds, "He loves books. He loves the Word. Collecting the Word is his hobby." Hugh's primary reading material

is his Bible. He also enjoys reading books written about the Word by well- respected ministers of the Gospel such as Kenneth Copeland and Kenneth Hagin. He collects book, tapes, and cds about the Word and his office is filled with them. God gave Hugh the idea of a Faith Resource Center for Harmony Ministries. "I wanted a place where people could get the faith resources they need." Today, people can go to the Harmony Faith Resource Center for Bibles, cds of the service, books, music and so much more.

Hugh is a man who loves the Word. Voncella explains, "He's into the Word. He can come home after a ten hour day at work, eat his dinner and go right into the Word and stay there until 11:30. I have to make him go to bed. He stays in the Word. We don't listen to music in the car, we listen to the Word. No matter where he goes, he's hearing the Word. He can take me to the store and he has the Word plugged into his ear while he's walking around



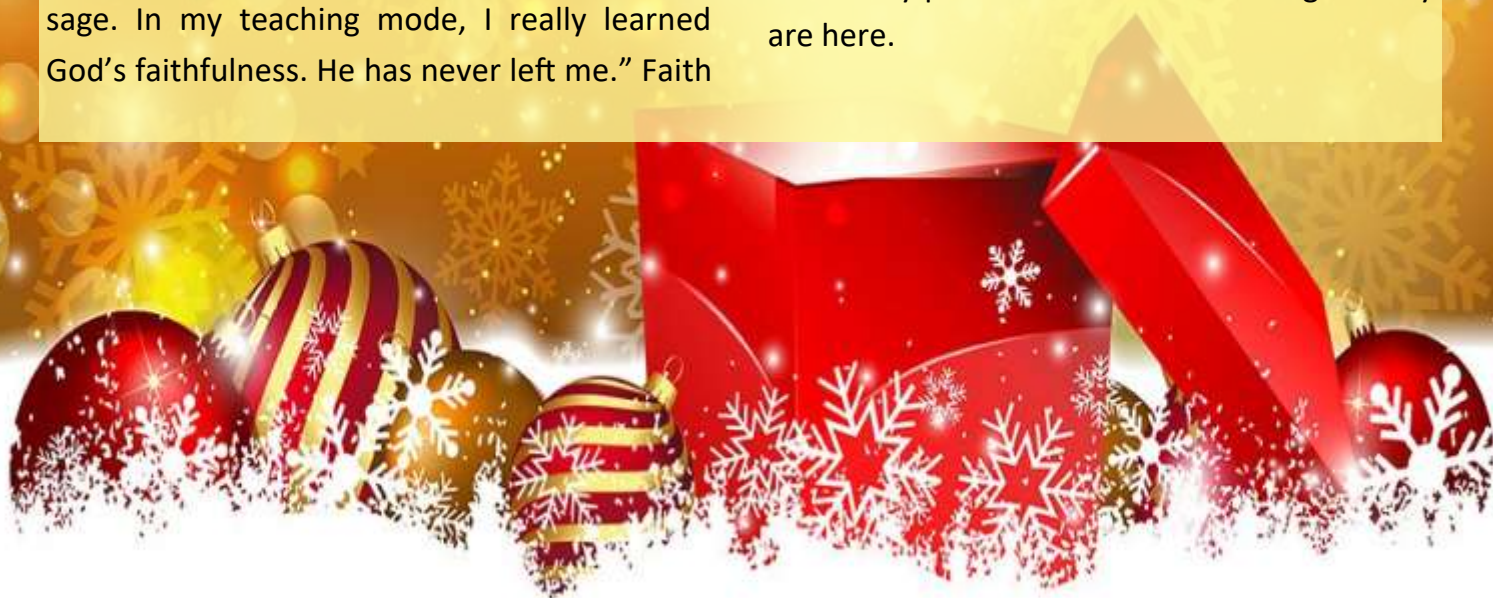


the store. The Word is always in him.” Hugh adds, “I know that faith comes by hearing so why wouldn’t I want to hear it again and again?” Hugh is a giver and supports several ministries. “I like to give. I like to see the Gospel go forth.”

As head of the Media Department, he supervises the making of cds of the Bible Studies and Sunday services, and videos which are posted on the Harmony app and YouTube. Although he is upstairs managing the Media Department, on the first Sunday of the month, you can find Hugh at the altar ready to serve Communion and on Wednesday morning, when Pastor is away, he teaches Bible Study. Hugh has been given the gift of teaching. “I may not be called to the five fold ministry but the Word (Romans 12:7) says let him who teaches, teach so I teach. It is enough.” Hugh admits that he has learned to trust the Lord when he is called upon to teach. He recalls a time when “I had no idea what to preach on, but as soon as I stepped off the balcony, He gave me a message. In my teaching mode, I really learned God’s faithfulness. He has never left me.” Faith

is an important part of the Stewart marriage. They have been married for 36 years. “Through Kenneth Copeland I learned about covenant. We are covenanted together I told her. If you leave, be prepared for me to follow.” Hugh and Voncella have a daughter, Nickelle and a granddaughter Tameka, 17 and a grandson Larnie, 15.

Deacon Hugh is dedicated to Pastor and to Harmony. He enjoys his work in the media department and the Word. “To be truthful, I don’t know where else I would go. There are a lot of churches where there is so much religion but not a lot of Word.” As for the future, Hugh is confident that God has a plan for him. “I know there is more to come. I know I’m not through yet; there is something left. I’m searching, looking to find it.” Hugh expects “to continue to grow (in Christ) and follow wherever He leads me.” For Deacon Hugh F. Stewart, Jr. and Voncella, Harmony Ministries, USA is the only place to be and we are so glad they are here.

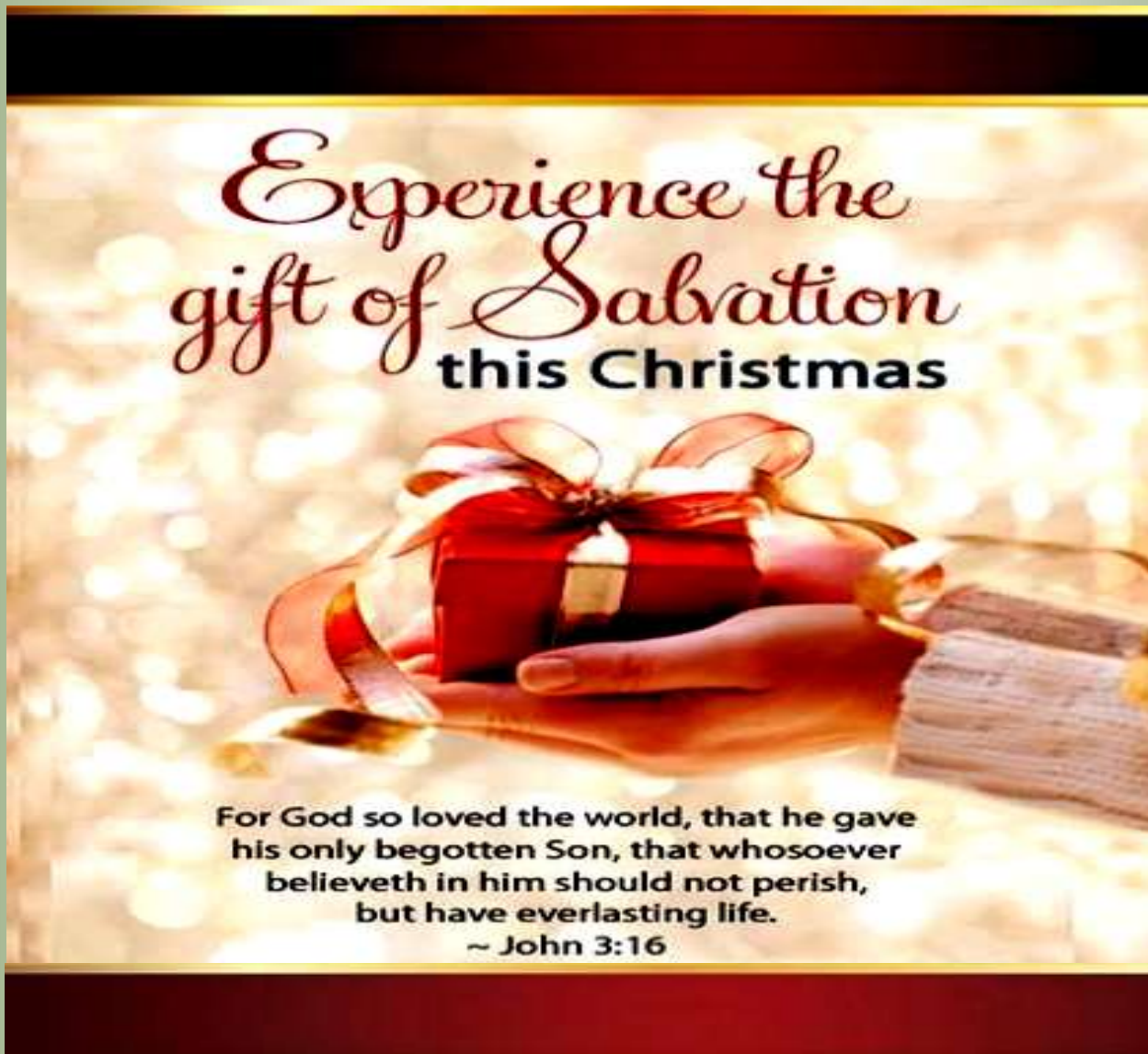
at the bottom of the bag? Learn what blessings you might be missing!

The Bible teaches that we are justified by the grace of God (Romans 3:24; Titus 3:7). Justified means declared not guilty. When we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, all charges against us are dropped and we are free from sin. When God forgives our sins, the record is wiped clean. It is as if we had never sinned.

A preacher once explained grace with this acronym:

**God's - Riches - At - Christ's - Expense**

Heavenly Father, In Jesus' name I repent of my sins and open my heart to let Jesus come inside of me. Jesus, You are my Lord and Savior. I believe you died for my sins and you were raised from the dead. Fill me with your Holy Spirit. Thank you Father, for saving me in Jesus' name. Amen.

# What Are You Doing With Your Salvation?

When God our Savior revealed His kindness and love, He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of His mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and a new life through the Holy Spirit. He generously poured out His Spirit upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior. Because of His grace, He made us right in His sight and gave us confidence that we will inherit eternal life. Titus 3:3-7 (NLT)

Recently Pastor Dennis Adams taught the congregation of Harmony Ministries on a Sunday morning about “Godzilla, the Power Within.” He was teaching us about the new birth, the anointing, and the power of the Holy Spirit within us, which is all part of our Salvation through the covenant that is sealed with the shed Blood of Jesus. As Pastor Dennis was teaching, this thought came to me: you have received your Salvation, but what are you doing with it? How would I answer that question if Jesus asked me?

Jesus died so that I could live an overcoming life, by walking in the power and authority that He has given me. I cannot love Jesus with all my heart, obey His Word, love the people around me and live a defeated inferior life. The two cannot co-mingle or reside together. Living in Christ is a life of victory and overcoming by looking from mountain top to mountain top. The Word of God states in 1John 4:4 (NLT), “But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a

victory over those people because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world.” All the answers, all the power, all the anointing, all the victory is on the inside of us. We should be inside minded at all times.

The Holy Spirit, who has been given to us, has all wisdom, power, and truth. Jesus stated in John 14:16-17 (AMPC), “And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, and Standby) that He may remain with you forever. The Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot receive (welcome, take to its heart, because it does not see Him or know and recognize Him for, He lives with you (constantly) and will be in you.”

I have listened to Pastor Dennis’ message many times and every time I listen, I hear something I had not heard before. One of the crucial points for me was sitting in my seat of authority daily. The Holy Spirit has revealed to me that He wants to teach me how to live purposely, not by miracles but by taking an “offensive position” against the devil and his cohorts, by responding with God’s Word, the name of Jesus and the Blood of Jesus in every situation, circumstance, problem, or pressure. Jesus has said in Luke 10:19 (AMPC) “Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, (and physical and mental strength and ability) over all the



power that the enemy (possesses); and nothing shall in any way harm you.”

The Holy Spirit teaches that by taking an “offensive position” consistently, I tell the enemy and his cohorts what they cannot do to me, my family, my loved ones, friends, neighbors, church members, my health, my finances, or God’s plan for my life by speaking God’s Word, in the Name of Jesus and the Blood of Jesus.
